Bopha bravely shares her stor to keep others safe

My hope is by sharing my story, others can be educated and empowered to prevent this heinous crime from happening to more innocent individuals.

Bopha

When Bopha met a stranger on Facebook who promised a highpaying job in China, her parents encouraged her to take it. It would change her life for the better.

But instead of a new job, Bopha was forced to marry a local man who abused her for years. When she could stand it no longer, Bopha escaped to the police, who helped her return to Cambodia and referred her to Hagar. With counseling, medical care, and entrepreneurship training, Bopha successfully reintegrated back into her community.

Today, Bopha has remarried and runs a small business with her husband. She bravely shares her story at Hagar prevention events to raise awareness about human trafficking and migration, and to keep other young women safe.

LIFT Joins Hagar to Accelerate Freedom Through Justice

In April 2023, LIFT International united with Hagar in a unique non-profit merger.

LIFT, formerly known as NVADER, was founded by Daniel Walker, the author of 'God in a Brothel' which features the stories of Hagar clients.

This integration accelerates access to justice, holistic care, and lasting freedom for survivors around the

world.
